- 11 the arrival of such alien in the State.

- 13 MENT.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no
- 14 alien eligible to be admitted to the United States under
- 15 this section shall be placed or resettled in a State if the
- 16 Governor of that State certifies to the Director of the Of-
- 17 fice of Refugee Resettlement that the Director has failed,
- 18 in the sole determination of the Governor, to provide ade-
- 19 quate assurance that the alien does not present a security
- 20 risk to the State.".
