**A BILL**

To require the denial of admission to the United States for individuals subject to sanctions pursuant to Executive Order 13876, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Strengthening Entry  
5 Visa Enforcement and Restrictions Act of 2025” or the  
6 “SEVER Act of 2025”.

1   **SEC. 2. DENIAL OF VISAS TO CERTAIN REPRESENTATIVES**  
2                           **TO UNITED NATIONS.**

3           Section 407(a)(1) of the Foreign Relations Author-  
4 ization Act, Fiscal Years 1990 and 1991 (Public Law  
5 101–246; 8 U.S.C. 1102 note) is amended by striking “;  
6 and” and inserting “, or is subject to sanctions pursuant  
7 to Executive Order 13876 (50 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating  
8 to imposing sanctions with respect to Iran), as in effect  
9 on September 16, 2025; and”.
