A BILL

To authorize congressional fellowships under the Skillbridge program.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Skillbridge Congres-5 sional Fellowship Act of 2025".

6 SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIPS UNDER THE
7 SKILLBRIDGE PROGRAM.

"(C) The Secretary concerned shall notify the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Legislative Affairs of each
member participating in a fellowship under this paragraph.

14 "(D) A fellowship under this paragraph may be no15 longer than 180 days.".
