To allow individuals to choose to opt out of the Medicare part A benefit.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Retirement Freedom
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. ALLOWING INDIVIDUALS TO CHOOSE TO OPT OUT
- 7 OF THE MEDICARE PART A BENEFIT.
- 8 Any individual who is otherwise entitled to benefits
- 9 under part A of title XVIII of the Social Security Act may
- 10 elect (in such form and manner as may be specified by

the Secretary of Health and Human Services) to opt out 2 of such entitlement. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in the case of an individual who makes such an 3 4 election, such individual— 5 (1) may (in such form and manner as may be 6 specified by the Secretary) subsequently choose to 7 end such election and opt back into such entitlement (in accordance with a process determined by the 8 9 Secretary) without being subject to any penalty; 10 (2) shall not be required to opt out of benefits 11 under title II of such Act as a condition for making 12 such election; and 13 (3) shall not be required to repay any amount 14 paid under such part A for items and services fur-15 nished prior to making such election.
