**A BILL**

To amend section 349 of the Immigration and Nationality Act to deem specified activities in support of terrorism as renunciation of United States nationality.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Expatriate Terrorists  
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LOSS OF NATIONALITY DUE TO SUPPORT OF TER-**  
7 **RORISM.**

8 Section 349(a) of the Immigration and Nationality  
9 Act (8 U.S.C. 1481(a)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “or” at the  
2 end;

3 (2) in paragraph (2)—

4 (A) by striking “or a political subdivision  
5 thereof” and inserting “, a political subdivision  
6 thereof, or a designated foreign terrorist organi-  
7 zation”; and

8 (B) by striking “or” at the end;

9 (3) in paragraph (3)—

10 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph  
11 (A), by striking “if” and inserting “or a des-  
12 ignated foreign terrorist organization if—”;

13 (B) in subparagraph (A), by striking “,  
14 or” and inserting “or intentionally targeting na-  
15 tionals of the United States for acts of terror;  
16 or”; and

17 (C) in subparagraph (B), by striking “or”  
18 at the end;

19 (4) by redesignating paragraphs (4), (5), (6),  
20 and (7) as paragraphs (5), (6), (7), and (8), respec-  
21 tively;

22 (5) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-  
23 lowing:

24 “(4) becoming a member of, or providing train-  
25 ing or material assistance to, any designated foreign

1 terrorist organization that such person knows, or  
2 has reason to know—

3 “(A) will engage in hostilities against the  
4 United States; or

5 “(B) will commit acts of terror against the  
6 United States or nationals of the United  
7 States;”;

8 (6) in paragraph (5), as redesignated—

9 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “he”  
10 and inserting “the person knowingly”; and

11 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking “alle-  
12 giance is required; or” and inserting “allegiance  
13 to the foreign state or political subdivision is re-  
14 quired;”; and

15 (7) in paragraph (6), as redesignated, by strik-  
16 ing “or” at the end.
