A BILL

- To require the Secretary of State to submit a report to Congress on the designation of the Muslim Brotherhood as a foreign terrorist organization, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Muslim Brotherhood
- 5 Terrorist Designation Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS.
- 7 It is the sense of Congress that—

1	(1) the Muslim Brotherhood meets the criteria
2	for designation as a foreign terrorist organization
3	under section 219(a) of the Immigration and Na-
4	tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189(a)); and
5	(2) the Secretary of State, in consultation with
6	the Attorney General and the Secretary of the
7	Treasury, should exercise the Secretary of State's
8	statutory authority by designating the Muslim
9	Brotherhood as a foreign terrorist organization.

6	(2) if the Secretary of State determines that
7	the Muslim Brotherhood does not meet the criteria
8	referred to in paragraph (1), includes a detailed jus-
9	tification as to which criteria have not been met.
10	(c) FORM.—The report required under subsection (b)
11	shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
12	a classified annex, if appropriate.
