3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "No Mask Mandates5 Act of 2021".

1 SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF FACE MASK ORDERS.

2 (a) TERMINATION.—Effective on the date of enact3 ment of this Act, the following shall be void and have no
4 force or effect:

5 (1) Executive Order 13991 (86 Fed. Reg.
6 7045), issued on January 20, 2021.

7 (2) The order issued by the Centers for Disease
8 Control and Prevention on January 29, 2021, pursu9 ant to section 361 of the Public Health Service Act
10 (42 U.S.C. 264), requiring persons to wear masks
11 while on conveyances and at transportation hubs.

(b) NO AUTHORITY TO ISSUE SUBSEQUENT ORDERS.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no
Federal agency or office may issue an order requiring persons to wear face masks in response to COVID-19.

16 SEC. 3. RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF PREVIOUSLY AP17 PROPRIATED FUNDS.

18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no funds 19 previously appropriated by Congress may be used by any 20 executive agency or department of the United States to 21 develop, implement, or otherwise enforce any Federal rule, 22 regulation, or order requiring persons to wear masks in 23 response to COVID-19.
