A BILL

To provide resources and incentives for the enforcement of
immigration laws in the interior of the United States
and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “ICE Agent Support
5 Act of 2016”.

6 **SEC. 2. USE OF FUNDS IN THE IMMIGRATION ENFORCE-**
7 **MENT ACCOUNT.**

8 Section 280 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
9 (8 U.S.C. 1330) is amended—

1 (1) by striking “Attorney General” each place
2 that term appears and inserting “Secretary of
3 Homeland Security”; and

4 (2) in subsection (b)(3), by striking subpara-
5 graph (A) and inserting the following:

6 “(A) The Secretary of the Treasury shall refund out
7 of the Immigration Enforcement Account to any appro-
8 priation the amount paid out of such appropriation for
9 expenses incurred by the Secretary of Homeland Security
10 for—

11 “(i) the identification, investigation, apprehen-
12 sion, detention, and removal of criminal aliens, in-
13 cluding the salaries and bonuses of officers and
14 agents of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforce-
15 ment and the administrative costs associated with
16 the hiring of such officer and agents;

17 “(ii) the maintenance and updating of systems
18 to identify and track criminal aliens, deportable
19 aliens, inadmissible aliens, and aliens illegally enter-
20 ing the United States; and

21 “(iii) the purchase of firearms, vehicles, and
22 other safety or apprehension equipment for officers
23 and agents of U.S. Immigration and Customs En-
24 forcement.”.

1 **SEC. 3. CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION SERIES POSITIONS IN**
2 **THE DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT AND RE-**
3 **MOVAL OPERATIONS OF U.S. IMMIGRATION**
4 **AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT.**

5 Not later than 30 days after the date of enactment
6 of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall es-
7 tablish the percentage of positions within the Enforcement
8 and Removal Operations division of U.S. Immigration and
9 Customs Enforcement that shall be classified as a criminal
10 investigator position, consistent with the requirements and
11 standards for occupational classification series 1811, dedi-
12 cated to enforcing the criminal statutory provisions of the
13 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.).
