**A BILL**

To apply laws that restrict the political speech of American citizens to media corporations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Free All Speech Act  
5 of 2014”.

6 **SEC. 2. APPLICATION OF LAWS THAT RESTRICT THE POLIT-**  
7 **ICAL SPEECH OF AMERICAN CITIZENS TO**  
8 **MEDIA CORPORATIONS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any law that restricts the political  
10 speech of American citizens shall apply with equal force

1 to media corporations, such as the New York Times, the  
2 American Broadcasting Company (ABC), the National  
3 Broadcasting Company (NBC), and the CBS Television  
4 Network.

5 (b) NO APPLICATION TO AMERICAN CITIZENS IF AP-  
6 PPLICATION TO MEDIA CORPORATIONS FOUND UNCONSTI-  
7 TUTIONAL.—To the extent that the application of a law  
8 to a media corporation under subsection (a) is found un-  
9 constitutional, such law shall have no force or effect with  
10 respect to American citizens.
