## A BILL

To provide for the meaningful participation of Taiwan in the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO).

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. MEANINGFUL PARTICIPATION OF TAIWAN IN

4 THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGA-5 NIZATION.

6 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con7 gress that—

8 (1) the International Civil Aviation Organiza9 tion (ICAO) should allow Taiwan to meaningfully
10 participate in the organization, including in ICAO

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triennial assembly sessions, conferences, technical
 working groups, meetings, activities, and mecha nisms;

4 (2) Taiwan is a global leader and hub for inter-5 national aviation, with a range of expertise, informa-6 tion, and resources and the fifth busiest airport in 7 Asia (Taoyuan International Airport), and its mean-8 ingful participation in ICAO would significantly en-9 hance the ability of ICAO to ensure the safety and 10 security of global aviation; and

(3) coercion by the Chinese Communist Party
and the People's Republic of China has ensured the
systematic exclusion of Taiwan from meaningful participation in ICAO, significantly undermining the
ability of ICAO to ensure the safety and security of
global aviation.

17 (b) PLAN FOR TAIWAN'S MEANINGFUL PARTICIPA18 TION IN THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION ORGANIZA19 TION.—The Secretary of State, in coordination with the
20 Secretary of Commerce, is authorized—

(1) to initiate a United States plan to secure
Taiwan's meaningful participation in ICAO, including in ICAO triennial assembly sessions, conferences, technical working groups, meetings, activities, and mechanisms; and

1	(2) to instruct the United States representative
2	to the ICAO to—
3	(A) use the voice and vote of the United
4	States to ensure Taiwan's meaningful participa-
5	tion in ICAO, including in ICAO triennial as-
6	sembly sessions, conferences, technical working
7	groups, meetings, activities, and mechanisms;
8	and
9	(B) seek to secure a vote at the next ICAO
10	triennial assembly session on the question of
11	Taiwan's participation in that session.
12	(c) Report Concerning Taiwan's Meaningful
13	PARTICIPATION IN THE INTERNATIONAL CIVIL AVIATION
14	Organization.—Not later than 90 days after the date
15	of the enactment of this Act, and not later than April 1
16	of each year thereafter for the following 6 years, the Sec-
17	retary of State, in coordination with the Secretary of Com-
18	merce, shall submit an unclassified report to the Com-
19	mittee on Foreign Relations of the Senate and the Com-
20	mittee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives
21	that—
22	(1) describes the United States plan to ensure
23	Taiwan's meaningful participation in ICAO, includ-
24	ing in ICAO triennial assembly sessions, con-

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1	ferences, technical working groups, meetings, activi-
2	ties, and mechanisms;

3 (2) includes an account of the efforts made by
4 the Secretary of State and the Secretary of Com5 merce to ensure Taiwan's meaningful participation
6 in ICAO, including in ICAO triennial assembly ses7 sions, conferences, technical working groups, meet8 ings, activities, and mechanisms; and

9 (3) identifies the steps the Secretary of State 10 and the Secretary of Commerce will take in the next 11 year to ensure Taiwan's meaningful participation in 12 ICAO, including in ICAO triennial assembly ses-13 sions, conferences, technical working groups, meet-14 ings, activities, and mechanisms.
